High School Students Studying in Burnaby and New Westminister

PREMIUM CUSTODIANSHIP & HOMESTAY SERVICES

Custodianship Set-up & Homestay Placement (One-Time)

Custodian documentation confirms that a designated Custodian is appointed to support an unaccompanied minor studying in Canada. Homestay arrangements are tailored to each student's needs, with a carefully screened Canadian host family assigned to them. A host family profile is sent for review before the student's arrival.

Homestay Full Board Accommodation (5 months or 10 months)

Homestay includes three meals daily (breakfast, lunch, dinner), a private furnished bedroom, telephone access (long distance not included), use of laundry facilities, and high-speed internet (no video streaming). Students must provide their own laptop and accessories.

Specialty Meal Enhancement (5 months or 10 months)

Students with specific dietary or medical needs will also be assessed a monthly stipend for special diet due to the higher costs. Specialty diets (e.g., high protein, vegan, gluten-free, halal) cannot be requested after the program starts unless medically necessary. Should the amount of food consumed be considered above average FCI reserves the right to charge this additional fee.

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Mandatory Custodial Monitoring (5 months or 10 months)

Unaccompanied minors studying in Canada must have a named Custodian to ensure ongoing care and support is available as required. Each student is assigned an FCI Custodian Representative, who provides ongoing guidance, organizes student activities, and assists with urgent issues when the assigned host family is unavailable.

[†] The dates of the district's mandatory orientation week vary from term to term and are outside our fixed 5-month and 10-month terms. Additionally, the cost increases if a student has requested the specialty meal enhancement.

[‡] Students are expected to arrive no earlier than the weekend prior to the school program start date and depart no later than the weekend immediately following the school program end date. Earlier arrivals or later departures must be pre-approved and the cost for additional nights will be based on the nightly fee rate.



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
